**The Juror and Judge: Doug Dawson** is a very familiar name in the pastel world. Mr. Dawson was inducted into the Pastel Society of America Hall of Fame in 2008. He was awarded the title of "Master Circle" by the International Association of Pastel Societies in 2005 and "Master of Pastel" status in 1985 by the Pastel Society of America.

Dawson has received numerous awards from many art organizations including: The Pastel Society of America, International Association of Pastel Artists, American Watercolor Society, Knickerbocker Artists, The National Academy of Western Art, Southern Pastel Society, Pastel Society of the West Coast, Audubon Artists, Kansas Pastel Society, Pastel Society of the Southwest and the International Association of Pastel Societies.

Dawson is the author of "Capturing Light and Color With Pastel" and has been a frequent contributor to publications on instructional art and pastel painting. Currently, Dawson teaches a plein air painting class at the Art Students League of Denver where he was a founding board member. He travels throughout the US judging shows and teaching workshops.

### Entry Procedures:

This exhibition is open to all artists 18 years or older, who are residents of eligible states . Work must have been completed within the past two years.

All original two-dimensional work may be entered. Paintings must be worked in the pastel medium. Oil pastels will not be accepted. Mixed media will be accepted, however, 70% of the work must be pastel. All artwork should be suitably framed under glass or Plexiglas.

Each artist may enter up to three (3) pieces. Entries may be represented by digital photos in JPEG format, with images of all entries copied onto one (1) CD and mailed to: **Gail Gamble, 1722 Hickory Gate Dr. S., Dunedin, FL 34698**. Entries should be labeled with artist's name, title and size. Example: JimSmith\_RiverWalk\_10x12.jpeg (artists may submit entries on slides, but digital entries on CD are preferred. Slides must be labeled with: artist's name, title of artwork,

dimensions and a red dot indicating the lower left corner of the slide.

Entrants are required to enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope for the return of unaccepted slides and juror notification. (CD's will not be returned.)

The entry fee is \$25.00 for the first artwork and \$10.00 each for the second and third pieces. (One piece/\$25.00, two pieces/\$35.00 & three pieces/\$45.00) Checks and money orders should be made payable to the Pastel Society of Tampa Bay (PSTB)

Entries must be postmarked by **February 15, 2011**. See the checklist on the registration form to insure that you have included all to make your entry complete.

### Delivery and Return of Accepted Artwork:

Accepted artwork must be shipped directly or hand-delivered to the Dunedin Fine Art Center, 1143 Michigan Blvd, Dunedin, FL 34698. Artwork must be received between April 23 and April 30, 2011. Artists are responsible for all shipping costs and in-transit insurance to and from DFAC. Shipped artwork must be sent prepaid in substantial, reusable containers. Payment for return shipping and a self-addressed shipping label should accompany the delivered artwork. (Prepaid UPS or Fed Ex label for returned shipping is preferable.) Work may be hand delivered to DFAC between April 23 and April 30. Work will be accepted M-F 10 am to 5 pm, Sat. 10 am– 2 pm and Sun. noon to 4 pm. Please call 727 298-3322 with any questions.

### Sales:

All artwork in the exhibition must be for sale. The Dunedin Fine Art Center receives a 40% commission from all sold work. Artists should price their work accordingly.



## Exhibition Agreement
